

# PARSON'S PADDOCK

## Background Information

Langhorne Creek has long been regarded as one of South Australia's best red wine producing regions. Plantings were relatively small until the mid 1990s, when vineyard plantings increased and the area became one of the state's key viticultural regions

## Tasting Notes

The wine has lifted aromas of chocolate and dark cherries with a richly flavoured palate of spicy ripe plum that finishes with smooth tannins. With superb length, it drinks beautifully now and will reward those with patience.

## Winemaker's Notes

Selected Cabernet Sauvignon from premium vineyards was vinified using a combination of fermentation styles and French oak to build complexity and structure.
